- Study of Crime and Punishment throughout different periods in history eg) Tudor period, Victorian period.

- Case study on Rosa Parks and focus on racism.
- Are all people treated in the same way in every country? (Middle East- gender equality- racism- George Floyd).

- Probability using probability scales to determine whether people are innocent or guilty.
- Look at crime data, over a period, and analyse the data. What conclusions can be drawn?

- CSI forensics activity- looking at crime scenes and different materials for finger printing.
- How has technology enabled us to catch criminals?
- Research of different punishments for crimes throughout history- E.g The Victorian Era.
