Transition

We have been working very closely with Bassaleg and our cluster primary schools to ensure that transition is well planned out within the covid-19 risk assessments that we are operating under at present.

Thursday 17th June – 9.00am – 11.00am Visit from Bassaleg staff to meet Year 6 – Mr Ford, Ms Williams and Mrs Booth will visit Pentrepoeth to meet Year 6 children.

Thursday 8th July – 1.00pm – 2.15pm - children will visit Bassaleg school to have a picnic on the field. The PE department will be on hand to work with year 6 on a variety of physical activities.

End of Year Activities

Gilwern visit – we have arranged for Gilwern Outdoor activity centre to visit school on Tuesday 13th and Wednesday 14th July. Children will have opportunities to take part in climbing wall activities, team building challenges and fire lighting/ camp craft in the Forest school area. There will be a strict risk assessment in place for this. As this will be quite expensive I would be grateful for a voluntary contribution from parents of £10 towards this.

Year 6 Picnic and Disco - this will take place on Thursday 15th July during the school day. Children can take part in team challenge games in the morning. There will be a picnic on the field at lunchtime followed by a disco. The picnic will be available from 'Tin Can' kitchen and will be paid for by the PTA (children will be able to order from a menu). We are hopeful to book an ice cream van for the end of the day too!

Friday 16th July Year 6 will take part in a fun physical activities and toasting marshmallows in the forest school area. The day will end with the traditional conga around the school.
