

Blended Learning

Blended Learning is an approach that uses both digital and traditional methods to help our children learn.

Our blended learning will combine a mixture of:

Learning at school

This assumes school is open to all pupils. Your child will continue to learn in the traditional way, led by the teacher but with opportunities to use digital tools like Google Classroom and See Saw. We will get the children used to these platforms by setting some tasks for them to use in school.

Learning at school and at home

This assumes that a child is off school because they are isolating – they have been told to isolate by Test, Trace and Protect or they or someone in their family is symptomatic and they are waiting for a test result. In any case, families will have consulted and agreed this with school

Learning at home

This is when a class contact group have been asked to isolate for a specific period of time because of a positive Covid case in the contact group – at our school a contact group is a class or the whole nursery. Class teachers are then available throughout the school day using Google Classroom and See Saw alongside recorded teaching clips.

Should a period of self-isolation be necessary for your child's contact group, the school will switch to a blended learning approach using Google Classroom (Years 2 to 6) and See Saw (Nursery – Year 1). Individual children self isolating should carry on with on the boil activities but parentsalso contact the school to discuss.

All children have been issued with a Home Learning book to use during this time. Login details for all platforms are available in the books. As during lockdown your class teacher will post a synopsis of the week's lessons and activities on our school website www.pentrepoethprimary.co.uk

Your child may need to complete activities via Google Classroom/See Saw or in their Home Learning book.

An example of the weekly plan is included below. Activities will be explained more fully in either Google Classroom or See Saw.

Pre-recorded Lessons

We will use a range of pre-recorded lessons and independent activities

This will allow children to manage the pace of their learning – pausing, reviewing and replaying

- Pre -recorded daily Mathematics and Numeracy and Language, Literacy and Communication taught lessons
- Weekly Topic taught lesson from one or more of the other Areas of Learning and Experience
- Range of independent activities that are 'on the boil'

Numeracy

Your child will be able to access a daily maths lesson where concepts are explained. The class teacher will be available via Google Classroom or See Saw to help with any problems your child may have.

Literacy

Your child will be able to access a daily English lesson where concepts are explained. The class teacher will be available via Google Classroom or See Saw to help with any problems they may have.

Topic

Your child will be able to access a weekly topic lesson that will lead to a range of activities for your child to complete.
