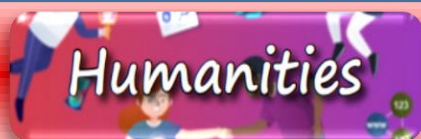
Topic/Theme – **Lights, Camera, Action**
