Head Lice

Dear Parent/Guardian, - Class 6RH

We have been informed of cases of head lice (nits) in 6RH. Head lice are very common among school-aged children and are spread through head-to-head contact. They are not a sign of poor hygiene.

Please could we ask all parents and carers to check your child's hair carefully and treat if necessary. It is important that everyone in the household is checked and treated at the same time to prevent reinfestation.

Key points from the NHS guidance:

- The only way to confirm head lice is by finding a live louse.
- Wet combing with a fine-toothed comb is an effective method.
- Medicated lotions and sprays are available if wet combing is not suitable.
- There is no need to keep your child off school if they have head lice.
