Goodbye Year 6 !



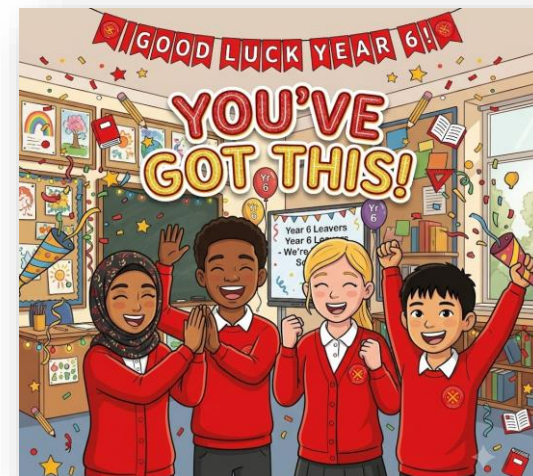

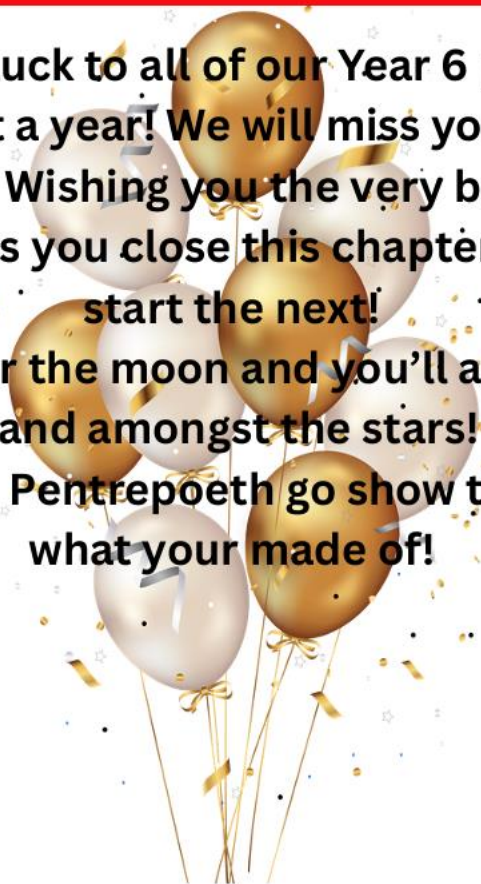

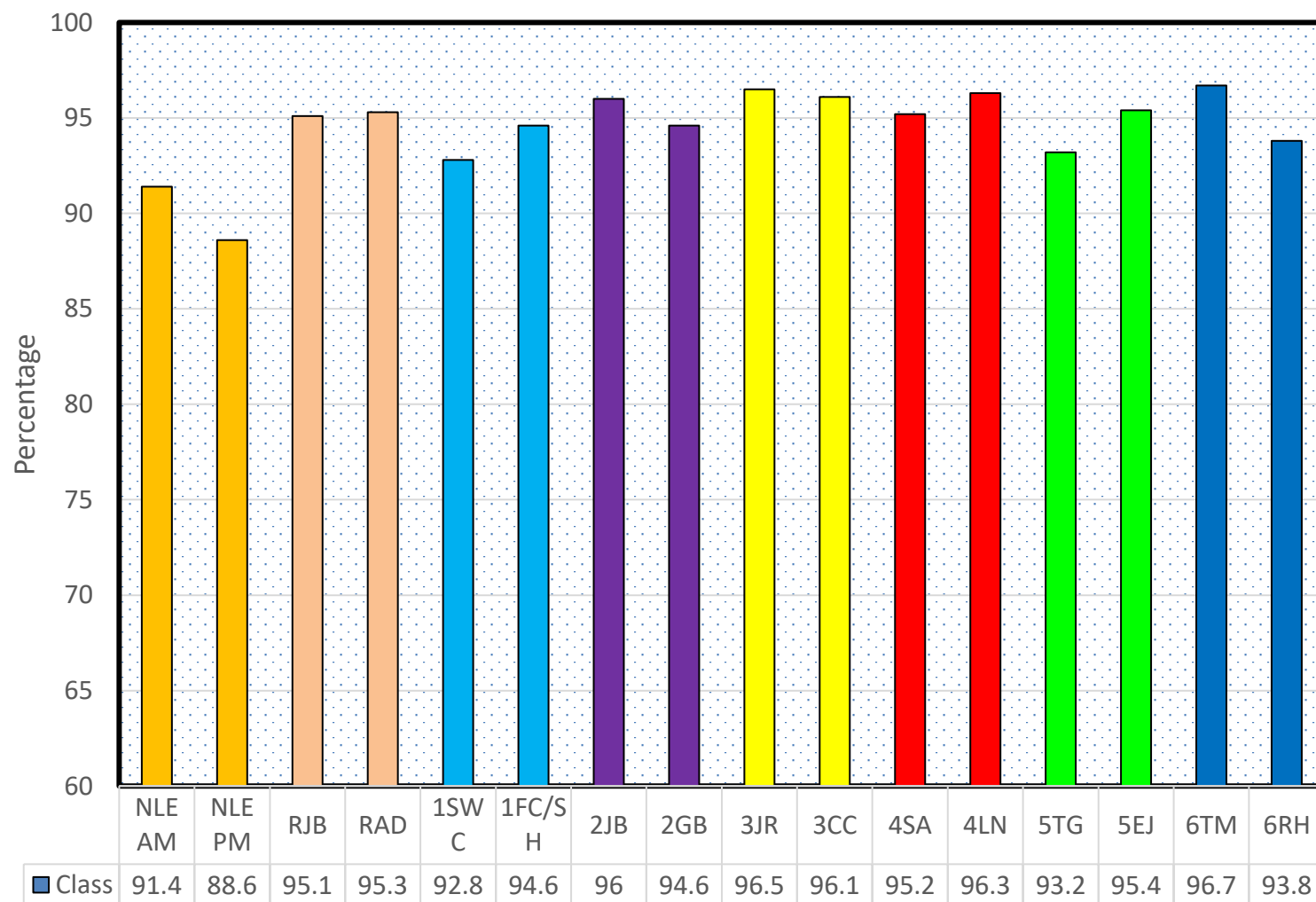
